

Timor-Leste Research Expedition: 17th November – 8th December 2026

This reconnaissance expedition represents a rare opportunity to conduct pioneering exploration where no rebreather divers have gone before. Diving the unexplored mesophotic depths of Timor-Leste and Ataúro Island — **home to the world's most biodiverse reefs** — we will execute specimen collection, ecological photogrammetry surveys, and research instrument deployment, pairing scientific objectives with local conservation and collaboration.

Expedition Field Research – *Not just a dive trip!*

Whether you dive or not, this expedition is designed to involve and train you in the methods, mindset, and skills of hypothesis-driven expedition field research. You'll learn at your skill level, build confidence and hours in the water, and leave with a foundation of transferable skills for future expedition work.

Dive Schedule:

The dive schedule runs 3–4 days diving with 1 degas/surface interval day. Variation depends on weather and research mission — this is remote-location expedition diving, and flexibility is certainly part of the adventure.

Degas days are an extension of our mission: beyond specimen study, we can explore the 40,000-year-old rock art of Nino Konis Santana National Park, kayak the sacred straits of Jaco Island, and trek to the sunrise summit of Mount Ramelau or the hidden Dokomali Waterfalls. This is a rare opportunity to explore one of the world's newest and least-explored nations.

Prices Do Not Include:

- Flights and baggage fees.
 - A 30-day visa on arrival (\$30 fee on arrival).
 - Equipment: participants are responsible for their own dive equipment including on board CCR cylinders.
 - Lunch & dinner (with the exception of dive operator refreshments).
- *Basic equipment e.g., mask, fins, snorkel, BCD, regulators are available for hire.

Eligibility and Requirements

- DAN insurance
 - CCR Divers: your own fully serviced rebreather and auxiliary equipment.
 - Highest diving certification.
 - Proof of 250 or more logged dives (SCUBA) or hours (CCR)**
 - Must sign expedition MOU, waiver and dive operator documentation.
- **Dive within your limits: certification, experience, and your own ability.

Recommendations

- Bring as much of your own equipment as you can – this is remote location diving.
